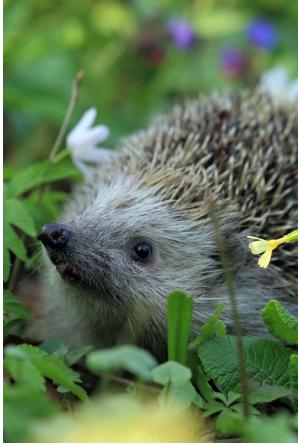

Young detective, “Dave Fun,” discovers all the alphabet letters by observing the world around him. In Book 1 and Book 1A, humorous stories about Dave and his family link the sounds and shapes of the lower and upper case alphabet letters. Singing the alphabet songs for each letter, together with actions, pictures and games all reinforces learning. Caregivers, including ECE teachers can play a crucial role in helping children develop skills for managing feelings and coping with fear and anxiety. For children to learn to manage these feelings effectively they need adult support and guidance. - We request that all participants refrain from wearing perfume, cologne and other fragrances, in order to promote a fragrance-free environment.
- Please remember that to reserve a space, payment must be received at the time of registration. Registrations will not be processed unless we have received payment. Payment may be made over the phone if paying by credit card and the amount being charged is a minimum of \$25.00.

Further, there will be a \$5.00 charge to replace any lost certificates.
- For all CCRR workshops a 48-hour cancellation policy is in effect. If you need to cancel and do so with the required 48 hour required notice, the workshop fee will be credited towards a future workshop at the CCRR. The credit is valid for one year from the date of the cancelled workshop.
- First - aid courses offered through Vital Link have a different cancellation policy. Please remember that once you have registered there are no refunds or transfers into another class unless written notification is received 72 hours prior to the class.
- Refunds for all other workshops will not be issued.
- If enrollment for any workshop is insufficient, the CCRR reserves the right to cancel or reschedule the class.
