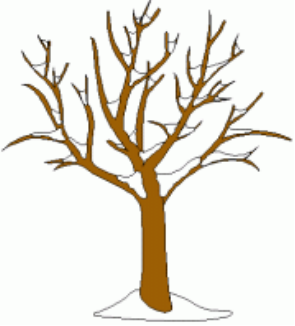



The course also includes basic first aid for common injuries such as bleeding, burns, falls, fractures, poisons and some medical conditions etc. There also is a section on child safety. The Emergency Child Care First Aid course is recommended for child care workers and anyone living with children.
